Rules and Regulations

1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club Limited Licensed Working Trials must be registered at the Kennel Club Limited in accordance with Kennel Club Limited Regulations for Classification and Registration B.
2. The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
3. All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Limited Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
4. The order of running shall be determined by a draw and the competitors notified accordingly by post of their reporting time prior to the day of the Trial.
5. Dogs under 18 calendar months of age on the closing date of the Trial are ineligible for entry.
6. Spayed bitches and castrated dogs may compete at the Trial.
7. Should circumstances so dictate the Society, in consultation with the judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them will be reported to the Kennel Club Limited.
8. Judges at a Trial are prohibited from entering a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership. Dogs will be disqualified if proved to have been handled by the scheduled judge's spouse or immediate family, or resident at the same address as the scheduled judge.
9. Not for competition entries are not accepted.
10. **DOGS IN CARS ON HOT DAYS:** Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog.

If your dog is found to be at risk, forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.
11. Welfare of Dogs: An exhibitor (or competitor) whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club Limited licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Limited Rules and Regulations.
12. In the event that the Trial is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, the Society will refund fees, less reasonably incurred expenses. If the Trial processor has the provisions to do so, competitors should be refunded in the manner in which they had entered the Trial. Alternatively, the Society will refund fees by cheque, to all those that had entered and requested a refund within 1 month of the Trial date.
13. *No modifications will be made to this Schedule except by permission of the General Committee of the Kennel Club Limited, which will be followed by advertisement in the Canine Press wherever possible.*
14. **OWNERS LIABILITY:** *Owners must accept fully liability for any injury to persons or property caused by their dogs and entries are accepted on the basis of owners indemnifying BWTS and its officers against all claims in respect thereof.*

15. *Entries must be received by the specified date and accompanied by the correct fee and a stamped addressed envelope. No entries will be returned in the case of inability to attend.*
16. *JUDGES: Should any of the judges be prevented from fulfilling their appointment, or any unforeseen circumstances arise, the Committee reserves the right to appoint another judge in his/her place and make any other arrangements deemed necessary.*
17. *All dogs compete at owner's risk. The Society and its officers will not be held responsible for any loss or damage arising from any cause whatsoever.*
18. *A dog will be disqualified and removed from the grounds if*
 - (a) *a bitch in season;*
 - (b) *suffering from an infectious disease;*
 - (c) *interfering with the chances of another competitor;*
 - (d) *of such temperament or lack of control as to pose a threat to the safety of any person or other animal; or*
 - (e) *unfit to compete or continue working.*

Classification and Definitions of Stakes

1. When entering Championship or Open Working Trials, wins at Members Working Trials will not count.
2. No Working Trial Stake shall be limited to less than 30. If a limit is imposed on entries in a Stake, it shall be carried out by ballot after the date of closing of entries.

DOGS IN CARS ON HOT DAYS

Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club Limited offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts of travelling to and whilst at KC licensed events.

1. When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.
2. Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.
3. Keep the dog in the shade – take your own shade, for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink, so your dog stays well hydrated.

Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.

WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.

Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club Limited licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Limited Regulations in this respect may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under the Kennel Club Limited Rules and Regulations.

Right to Refuse Entries: Exhibitors/Competitors are reminded that show societies have the right under Kennel Club Limited Regulation to refuse any entry.
